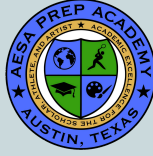


AESA PREP ACADEMY



Admissions Process Checklist

- Submit an inquiry form for EACH applying student via the school website
- Schedule a tour and meet with the applicant's respective Head of School
- After the tour, you will be sent the Student Application to complete Pt. 1
- Schedule the student's Shadow Day with the respective Head of School
(only for school year applicants, summer applicants may be required to do a separate interview/assessment)
- Complete and submit all portions of the Student Application, except required uploads, BEFORE the student's scheduled Shadow Day
- Student attends Shadow Day *(if applicable, the student will meet with the Director of Academics for an informal assessment)*
- After Shadow Day, you will be resent the Student Application, to complete Pt. 2 and upload the required supplemental documents*
- Once an application is approved, you will be notified by email or phone
- The contract will be sent by AESA CFO, Rick Garza
- Return the signed contract with a \$1000 deposit
- The student is officially enrolled at AESA Prep Academy

Required Supplemental Uploads*

- 1st-12th Grade Report Cards- Current and Previous Year
- 3rd-12th Grade Reference Letters (*Optional K-2nd*)
 - Character Reference
 - Language Arts and Math Ability Reference

- Student Writing Samples

Please include all the student writing samples in the same document. This may be handwritten or typed. Please have students provide their answers and only help if guidance is needed.

- 3rd -5th Grade Applicant Questionnaire (*Optional K-2nd*)

- What do you like best about yourself?
- How would your friends describe you?
- What is your favorite thing to learn while at school?
- What activity would you hope to participate in at AESA that you do not have at your current school?

- 6th-12th Grade Applicant Questionnaire

- What do you like best about yourself?
- What are you most concerned about?
- How would your friends describe you?
- Please tell us why you are interested in attending AESA.

- 3rd-12th Grade Student Activity Resume- *Please list the academic and non-academic activities in which you have participated. Some students have more opportunities available to them in their school or community than others. Do not worry if you don't have many, the purpose is to get to know you and your family.*

- Fine Arts
- Community Service

- 4th-12th Grade Personal Statement-*Write a 1-2 page letter to AESA describing your personal goals, passions, and developing interests. What would you like us to know about your character, your strengths and weaknesses, and your life experiences?*
